Vonda Lorraine Koch, 90

MINDEN – Vonda Schories Koch was born on April 5, 1929 on a farm in Harrison County to her parents, Gustav and Bertha (Ronfeldt) Schories. She was the fourth of eight children. She attended country school by Portsmouth and graduated from Tennant High School in Tennant in 1947. In her junior and senior years, Vonda played on the basketball team. After graduation, Vonda was a live-in housekeeper for Dr. Patterson, the veterinarian



in Minden. It was while working for Dr. Patterson that Vonda met John Koch. They were married on August 20, 1950 at the Minden Congregational Church.

They started their married life on John's family farm, south of Neola. There they raised three children, one daughter Sheila, and two sons, Robert and Timothy. Vonda was a homemaker and helped John with every aspect of farming for the first 20 years of marriage. Then she took a job as a cook at the County Home in McClelland for seven and one-half years.
